Summary of the 2023 Annual General Meeting of Shareholders of Accenture plc

On Wednesday, February 1, 2023, Accenture plc held its Annual General Meeting of Shareholders in Dublin, Ireland.

At the meeting, the shareholders voted to:

- appoint Jaime Ardila, Nancy McKinstry, Beth E. Mooney, Gilles C. Pélisson, Paula A. Price, Venkata (Murthy) Renduchintala, Arun Sarin, Julie Sweet and Tracey T. Travis to the Board of Directors;
- approve, in a non-binding vote, the compensation of Accenture's named executive officers;
- approve, in a non-binding vote, the frequency of future non-binding votes to approve the compensation of Accenture's named executive officers to be one year;
- ratify, in a non-binding vote, the appointment of KPMG LLP as Accenture's independent auditor and authorize, in a binding vote, the Audit Committee of the Board to determine KPMG's remuneration;
- grant the Board the authority to issue shares under Irish law;
- · grant the Board the authority to opt-out of pre-emption rights under Irish law; and
- determine the price range at which Accenture can re-allot shares that it acquires as treasury shares under Irish law.
